

# TIPL Terms of Service

By using the reach2every1.com web site (“Service”), or any services of Techoptions Info Solutions Pvt Ltd (“TIPL”), you are agreeing to be bound by the following terms and conditions (“Terms of Service”).

TIPL reserves the right to update and change the Terms of Service from time to time without notice. Any new features that augment or enhance the current Service, including the release of new tools and resources, shall be subject to the Terms of Service. Continued use of the Service after any such changes shall constitute your consent to such changes. Violation of any of the terms below will result in the termination of your Account. While TIPL prohibits such conduct and Content on the Service, you understand and agree that TIPL cannot be responsible for the Content posted or send using the Service and you nonetheless may be exposed to such materials. ## Account Terms

1. You must be 13 years or older to use this Service.

3. You must provide your legal full name, a valid email address, and any other information requested in order to complete the signup process.
4. Your login may only be used by one person – a single login shared by multiple people is not permitted. You may create separate logins for as many people as your plan allows.

## API Terms

## Payment, Refunds, Upgrading and Downgrading Terms
